Minutes of the College Governing Council Meeting held on September 7th, 2000

Agenda No.01: Shifting to the new and Permanent site at Thandalam

<u>Discussion:</u> Prof. Arumugham reported that he visited the new campus and reviewed the progress of the Construction work. According to him the availability of classrooms, Laboratories, space for canteen etc., are quite adequate. He noted that through AICTE has prescribed 66 sq.mt. He also pointed out the workshop is coming under REC roof and appreciated the quality of construction.

Mr. S. Meganathan, Chairman informed that adequate space has been earmarked for landscaping, garden and trees to ensure a green campus in the coming years.

The council resolved to expedite the activities and visit the new campus before shifting to the new campus in May 2001.

Agenda No.02: Performance of the students of the I batch (1997-98):

Discussion: Dr. S. Muthu, Member, after going through the results of the I batch, available up to VI Semester, urged the Principal and Staff to strive hard to bring the I batch pass percentage as high as possible. He appreciated the individual performance of a few students in ECE, Particularly Mr. Sudeep Ghosh.

Agenda No.03: Faculty Recruitment:

Dr. S. Muthu emphasized the importance of recruiting highly qualified and experienced faculty members during the next (April - May 2001) recruitment to improve the results and other co-curricular activities. He pointed out that as the number of engineering colleges are steadily increasing, it is quite difficult to get suitable candidates to teaching positions.

He further pointed out that the number of faculty appointed should be complying to the AICTE guidelines of Student Faculty Ratio applicable from time to time. In this background, the Governing Council resolved to authorize the Managing Trustee to sanction the required number of positions and the Principal to take necessary steps to recruit qualified and experienced faculty as per the number of sanctioned positions.

Prof. Arumugham informed that during the next recruitment, emphasize will be given to identify candidates with high scores in specific subjects among the applicants as to groom them in a particular specialization.

Agenda No.04: Approval of Staff Selection Committee:

Dr.S.Arumugham put up the Composition of Selection Committee to recruit the Faculty members for the approval of the Council. Dr.S.Muthu appreciated the inclusion of a lecture demo in the selection process through which the audibility, presentation skills and the body language of the faculty member can be well assessed. As per the composition, the Committee will comprise of Chairperson, Principal, Head of the Department Concerned and one or two subject experts as the case may be.

The Council after discussion approved the Composition and Constitution of Selection Committee for the recruitment of faculty members.

Agenda No.05: Transport Facilities:

The Chairman informed that in view of the Shifting of the College to the new campus at Thandalam, which is 25 KMs away from Chennai, more buses (around six) are to be purchased and activities are in progress in this regard.
