The total credits for the programmes will be thus increased by two credits for the students admitted in the academic year 2022-23 onwards.

As per AICTE APH-2023-24, institutions can introduce programmes, in collaborations with foreign universities, meeting certain norms and accordingly,

REC has entered into an agreement with Binghamton University, USA for accommodating the UG students to pursue a part of the programme and earn credits from Binghamton University, USA

Among the different modes of collaborations recommended by AICTE in APH 2023-24, REC has chosen the (3+1) twinning programme, with First 3 years of study at REC and the final one year of study at Binghamton University, USA

The Binghamton University, USA is offering various programmes, from which the following programmes are identified by REC for 3+1 twinning programme

- i. B.S. Computer Science of Binghamton University, USA for students admitted in B.E. Computer Science and Engineering and B.Tech. Information Technology
- ii. B.S. Computer Engineering of Binghamton University, USA for students admitted in B.E. Electronics and Communications Engineering
- iii. B.S. Industrial and Systems Engineering of Binghamton University, USA for students admitted in B.E. Aeronautical Engineering

From the ensuing academic year 2023-24, it is proposed to offer only B.E. Computer Science and Engineering under the twinning programme (3+1 scheme), since there is a demand for this programme among the students.

The Board of Studies of Computer Science and Engineering has recommended the above twinning programme and the minutes of the BoS meeting of this programme, MoA (Memorandum of Agreement) between REC and BU, USA, and Curriculum mapping are submitted for the council's perusal.

Further, if a student of this twinning programme is unable to pursue his / her fourth year of study at Binghamton University, USA, as per the norms, due to unavoidable reasons, such as denial of VISA, health issues, etc., those students may be permitted to complete their fourth year in Rajalakshmi Engineering College itself, to meet the requirements for the award of the degree (As per AICTE APH 2023-24).

After going through the 3 listed twinning programmes offered by Binghamton University, USA, there was a detailed discussion regarding the B.E. Computer Science and Engineering and B.Tech. Information Technology, since REC presently intends to take up this programme for the students joining First year programme in 2023.

The Council formally approved the introduction of twinning programme for B.E. Computer Science and Engineering and B.Tech. Information Technology subject to fulfilling the following norms:

- All the theory courses pursued in the 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> semesters should be professional electives.
- If there are any core subjects in the 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> semester presently listed in the curriculum, they are to be moved to 6<sup>th</sup> Semester with the approval of BOS.
- To map the Final year projects of REC, the 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> semester curriculum of foreign university have to be suitably adjusted so that exact credit mapping is satisfied through projects / internships.
- Before the end of 6<sup>th</sup> Semester, course learning agreement has to be executed by both REC and foreign university for each of the student enrolled under this programme.
- The eligibility criteria for those opting for taking up of Twinning programme should be listed in the REC Regulations
- The Council also added that the introduction of this programme is subject to the approval of the Anna University, Chennai.

Regarding the other two twinning programmes for B.E. Electronics and Communications Engineering and B.E. Aeronautical Engineering, the Anna University representatives suggested that they can be placed in the next meeting of the Academic council after the detailed study of the credit mapping by the respective Boards of Studies.
